## This bus is open to everyone

In steps ① to ④, we will introduce how to ride the community bus. Please give it a try.

### ① Wait at the bus stop

★ We will not leave earlier than scheduled, but please allow plenty of time for your departure.

★ Some stops have signs on only one side of the road.

Please wait on the opposite side of the sign (in the direction of direction of travel).

### ② Raise your hand and appeal

★ If you see a bus, please notify the driver.

★ There are several types of community bus designs.



### ③ Get on

★ Sit wherever you like.

★ Fares are paid in arrears.

★ There are no numbered tickets.



### ④ Get off the bus

★ If you want to get off at the next stop, please let the driver know by buzzer or verbally.

★ Pay the fare in cash or with a coupon and get off the bus.

### ★ Fare

	Weekdays	Holiday (Saturdays, Sundays, holidays, year-end and New Year)
Adult	200 yen	500 yen
Junior high school students and younger	100 yen	200 yen

### ★ Coupons

Coupons are sold for 2,000 yen per 30 100 yen tickets.

Sales location : Sanuki City Hall (toshi seibi-ka)
